# An Open Letter

Dear Scientologists,

On the 7th of October AD 34 a convention was held at Saint Hill Manor, in England. Scientologists from Churches all around the world came together to discuss ways to speed our expansion.

At every point of the Church of Scientology's greatest expansion in the past 34 years, we have been faced with harassment and discrimination, in an effort to slow or hinder our progress, from that small percentage of the planet that do not wish to see freedom for all.

At this convention a PLEDGE TO MAN-KIND was made to achieve the Aims of Scientology of "A civilization without insanity, without criminals and without war, where the able can prosper and honest beings can have rights, and where Man is free to rise to greater heights," without reservation or any thought of personal safety. The purpose of this pledge was to affirm the dedication of Scientologists around the world as a group to this common goal.

In order to achieve the intention of this pledge, it was unanimously concurred that an INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF SCIENTOLOGISTS be formed which has the purpose to UNITE, ADVANCE, SUPPORT AND PROTECT SCIENTOLOGY AND SCIENTOLOGISTS IN ALL PARTS OF THE WORLD SO AS TO ACHIEVE THE AIMS AND PURPOSES OF SCIENTOLOGY.

The Association recognizes the fact that there has been oppression of Religion and Freedom from time to time throughout history and, in order to assure the unimpeded expansion of Scientology, it shall not take any action which would subject it to the Power of any Nation at a time when that Nation tolerates, aids or engages in, the harassment or oppression of any Religion or of Mankind, but shall take all appropriate actions to ASSURE THAT ALL MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION MAY CONTINUE TO PRACTICE AND DISSEMINATE FREELY AND CONTINUOUSLY.

It is the intention of the Association to gather and unite all Scientologists on this planet and create a worldwide, strong true group through the contribution and participation of all Scientologists. This would truly be a new, strong, third Dynamic for ALL Scientologists the world over.

"A group is not a collection of individuals. A group is a living thing to which individuals can belong. The soul of a society is its culture, and it flows across the generations. The sum of the aberration of a group is not the sum of the aberrations of its individuals. The group gets engrams in another way. And the sum of the individuals, each having different aberrations, will throw into being highly rational thought. A number of individuals cancel out the aberrations of one another."

On the 9th of October, 1984, following the convention, the Association began its operations.

This is a membership association and will be keeping all members briefed as a true group through a very special International Magazine. The Association will ensure that, without question, Scientology philosophy will be delivered despite any effort to halt or slow Scientology delivery or dissemination in any Nation or Continent around the world. In other words, this Association is the guarantee that The Bridge gradation and awareness chart to Total Freedom will be open to you, as a member, forever, as well as to your family and friends.

The Association will support actions to tackle the oppression of the Scientology religion and Scientologists directly by the dismantling of groups and organizations dedicated to the harming, oppression or control of Mankind and will directly support and assist all groups of whatever race, creed or color that are forwarding freedom for all mankind.

The Association will support and further the dissemination and expansion of the Scientology

### b) HONOR ROLL STATUS.

The Association will specifically award Honor Roll Status to any member who signs up 20 new members as such will be directly helping to meet the goals set by the Association. The Association will similarly acknowledge with Honor Roll Status any member making exceptional donations to help the Association in building its "war chest" which will be used solely for the guarantee that the Scientology religion may expand and be delivered undisturbed throughout the free world, including those members who make donations to the war chest in excess of \$20,000.

The names of these individuals are placed on the Official Honor Roll plaque at Saint Hill Manor and are awarded an Association pin. The Honor Roll is also published in full in each issue of the Association's magazine, IMPACT.

### c) PATRON STATUS.

The Association's honor title of Patron may be awarded to those members who have made extraordinary donations to the Association's "war chest". Certain members have donated in excess of \$40,000 to the Association's war chest so that the goals of the Association may be attained.

The Honor Status of Patron of the Association entitles the member to a presentation plaque and the Association's solid gold patron pin. Their names are engraved on a special plaque at the Flag Land Base and published in the Association's magazine. Patrons are also entitled to special briefings and other honors as determined by the Association. Additionally, the Church of Scientology has decided to further honor Patrons with preferential treatment on all Church service lines in recognition of their contributions to the

Association which is the Church's officially adopted membership system.

- 8. Beginning Members may obtain Annual Membership or Lifetime Membership at any time. Annual Members may obtain Lifetime Member ship at any time.
- 9. Membership in any category is not trans ferable between persons, nor is any right, benefit or privilege of Membership transferable.
- 10. The Association accepts donations in any amount from Members or non-members for the furtherance of its purpose and the realization of its goals.
- 11. Membership fees and donations to the As sociation are not refundable.
- 12. Membership in any category, or Associate status, may be cancelled immediately and without notice should the Member, or Associate, publicly disavow or attack the Association or, in the case of a Member, fail to remain in good standing with the Church of Scientology.
- 13. Members are required to keep their mail ing address up to date with the Association so vital communication may be relayed. The Association in turn, will guarantee that such information is kept secure and only used in forwarding the aims of Scientology and the purpose of the Association.
- 14. Members have the right to help in fighting our battles and in the dissemination of our many wins.

# Pledge to Mankind

Time and again, throughout the troubled history of civilization on this planet, new ideas, new religions and constructive thought have met with violent opposition. Such attacks come from those who would preserve the status quo and particularly from those who seek to preserve and enhance their position through the domination, subjugation and even destruction of others. For this reason new religions have been born in blood at the cost of great sacrifice and suffering by adherents. It is only through a unity of purpose and unswerving commitment by a dedicated group that new ideas and new religions survive and expand.

The Scientology religion has been in existence now for some thirty-four years. During that time it has suffered all manner of attacks from the forces of oppression in various countries. Yet the Scientology religion has survived and expanded because of the dedication of its members and because it is a force for goodness and freedom which is easily recognized by men of goodwill; despite the vicious lies which are spawned by those who would enslave mankind and which are carried by the media.

The Scientology religion is experiencing the greatest expansion and prosperity in its history. International in scope, each week it frees more people from the debilitating effects of drugs, ignorance and other sources of aberration and moves them on the path to greater awareness, self-respect and dignity than all other groups combined.

Yet as we have learned in our thirty-four years, whenever we expand, we are attacked, commensurate with that expansion. And today is no exception.

In the United States, which was once thought to be a haven of religious liberty, we are the targets of unprincipled attacks in the court system by those who would line their pockets from our hard won coffers. Bigots in all branches of government, fearing the success of Scientology technology, are bent on our destruction through taxation and repressive legislation.

We have been subjected to illegal heresy trials in two countries before prejudiced and maUnformed judges who are not qualified or inclined to perceive the truth. In Canada and Germany, our Churches have been subjected to vicious raids reminiscent of the historical genocide attacks on religions that took place in "less informed" times and societies.

The news media chooses to ignore the good works and miraculous successes of Scientology technology and instead seeks to poison public opinion through vilification of the religion and its Founder.

The detractors of the Scientology religion know full well that it is a proven, effective and workable system for freeing mankind from spiritual bondage. That is why they attack. They fear that they will somehow be threatened by a society which is more ethical, productive and humane through the influence of the Scientology religion and Scientologists. Thus when we expand, to that degree we are attacked.

Up to this day, the responsibility for defending the Scientology religion has been on the shoulders of a desperate few. And so it will continue in large measure.

Yet, in order to continue the quest for a new civilization where honest men have rights and freedoms abound, the assistance and dedication of each and every Scientologist and other men of goodwill is essential. The road may be difficult and may get worse due to the rapid decline of civilization and erosion of personal liberties at this time. But united in purpose and dedication, we shall prevail for the benefit of all mankind.

We, the undersigned, pledge ourselves, without reservation or any thought of personal comfort or safety, to achieving the Aims of Scientology: 'A civilization without insanity, without war, where the able can prosper and honest beings can have rights, and where Man is free to rise to greater heights."

We invite Scientologists and other well-intentioned people everywhere to join us in this pledge.

- 3. Training Scholarship Awards, Professional Rates on processing, special offers that will be announced from time to time on services and materials, will be available only to Association Members.

- 4. In celebration of the formation of the In ternational Association of Scientologists, and the Church's adoption of the Association as its official membership system, the Church has issued special member-only donation rates that run as much as 20 percent less than non-member (general public) donation rates. Missions and Field Audi tors may also offer special rates, but are not obligated to do so. Such rates are not additional to Training Scholarships, Professional Rates or any other systems in use and the Church's policy of No Double Discounts applies with the exception of the time-honored 5% prepayment discount which may be used at any time.
- 5. The Church has also extended special membership rates for all bookstore items that, as well, run 20 percent less than non-member (gen eral public) rates, continuing to follow its time-honored Special Membership donation rates on all bookstore items.
- 6. For Association Members, the membership fee for the <sup>(t)</sup>I WANT TO GO OT\*"CLUB is reduced by one half with evidence of Association Membership. Thus, Association members may become part of this club designed to help you to go up The Bridge to Total Freedom gradation and awareness chart to full OT status.
- 7. The Church will provide a channel for ac tive participation by you as an Association member in the task that lies before us: to forward the purpose of the Association, and so achieve in full the Aims of Scientology as announced by L. Ron Hubbard.

# Politics, Freedom From by L. Ron Hubbard

- 1. I hereby declare Scientology to be non-political and non-ideological.
- 2. Politics and ideology may be no part of any decision to train or process individuals, and any such interrogation shall cease to be a part of any application for training, processing or membership.
- 3. This does not change any policy relating to suppressive persons. It does delete any words in any form which seek to bring about a statement of political allegiance or antagonism.
- 4. It must be kept in mind and brought forward emphatically that Scientology does not work in the absence of official control and no matter who sought to use its principles, has uniformly failed in the hands of non-Scientologists and organizations not controlled by the Central Organizations of Scientology or myself.
- 5. The reason for this declaration is the consistent disaster visited upon her "allies" by the United States government and the efforts of that government since 1955, stepped up since 1963, to seize Scientology in the United States rather than forbid or stop it and the role played by the United States in inspiring the Victorian State at tacks in Australia. Scientology technology is no longer offered to the United States government in any effort to assist her in political ends. Our

- participation extends only to our willingness to process U.S. officials as individuals unconnected with their political aims, if as individuals they are not debarred by other existing policies relating to treating the insane or our Ethics system.
- 6. All statements attacking any political entity or ideology are hereby withdrawn and cancelled in any lectures or literature.
- 7. Scientologists may be members of any political group on this planet without restraint only so long as these individuals or that group do not attempt to seize Scientology for their own warlike ends and so make it unworkable or distasteful by invidious connection.
- 8. Scientology is for a free people and is itself on this date declared free of any political connection or allegiance of any kind whatever.

# Attacks on Scientology by L. Ron Hubbard

Having had some time to think this over and having studied the matter with great care, I have isolated the most successful response to meeting any and all attacks on Scientology, its organizations and Scientologists and as of this date this becomes policy.

### ADVOCATE TOTAL FREEDOM

That is the policy — advocate total freedom.

There are technical reasons for this which an auditor will recognize. To discharge later incidents from a mind, one must get the first or basic incident of that kind. In this case the basic aberrated incident was the suppression of freedom of the being. Just before that there must have been freedom. Thus advocating total freedom hits the true basic incident.

This is also the basic purpose of Scientology and the basic purpose of people, so it all agrees well.

This is also easiest to do. It is easier than fighting Parliaments or building up cases against people who attack us.

The only liability of using this policy (total freedom) is that it releases energy (a Scientologist knows this as "blowing locks") which looks disturbing but is weakened.

No other approach we have used worked. We are alive not because we fought but because we went on doing Scientology in spite of anything.

So never advertise an attack. Just advocate more strongly 'Total Freedom!" and show how Scientology can attain it for the individual.

Careful summary of our past actions in the face of attacks and an analysis of various changes in human history show that the best and *only* effective thing we did or anyone ever did was advocate freedom. The precise practice of Scientology obtains total freedom so never advertise anything else but total freedom and the Scientology services and steps that bring it about. Courses, processing are the gradient scale to total freedom.

That's the answer no nation or person can stand up to — if we keep saying it long and loud. SCIENTOLOGY IS THE ROAD TO TOTAL FREEDOM.

Used in argument one can invent reasons to baffle the attacking agency or person — but all these reasons should add up to everyone has rights to total freedom.

I think this alone can move mountains.

# What We Expect of a Scientologist

by L. Ron Hubbard

We inherited, when we began, a great many hidden errors in the society, so deeply laid they seemed right. "Everybody knows that . . . ." is a tombstone of progress for it contains uninspected lies that bring the wittiest of us to grief. "Everybody knows that Man is Evil" was only one of the many things we found wrong, exposed and dropped from our own knowledge.

However, in the field of what is expected of a Scientologist, we have for ten years carried along an inherited error. Tt is this: "Everybody knows that a specialist in a science hangs out a shingle and, if a professional, becomes a private practitioner.'\*

Now listen. Psycho-analysis was developed in 1894 by Sigmund Freud. Everybody who studied it was expected to hang out a shingle and start practising. It took half a century for psycho-analysis to become generally known by the people. Yet how could it miss? Its tenet was that if you were sexually uninhibited you would be happy.

The psycho-analyst took his cue from the medico of his day. If you could heal you were a healer with a shingle.

Well, I'm afraid a lot of us have bought this too. If we were trained in Scientology as a professional we should hang out our shingle as a practitioner. With all due respect to the Scientologist in professional practice (where they have every right to be) this is not a true idea. It is a borrowed idea. It's as old as the witch doctor.

A Scientologist is the being three feet behind society's head. And society runs on eight dynamics, not in a sick room. Some of us, of course, would become professional practitioners. But a professional Scientologist is one who expertly uses Scientology on any area or level of the society.

A housewife who does not have professional level skill in Scientology could not expect to run a wholly successful family or keep order in her neighbourhood and keep her family well. A factory foreman could not possibly handle his crews with full effectiveness without professional Scientology skill. The personal assistant to a corporation executive could not do a fully effective job without being a professional Scientologist, A corporation president without a certificate will someday fail. And the head of a country would go to pieces if he didn't know Scientology from a professional angle.

How can these people handle life if they have no expert knowledge of how to handle life.

Now we don\*t expect everyone in the world to become a trained auditor. But we expect the people who are making the world to have a knowledge of how to make it go.

A *trained* Scientologist is not a doctor. He is someone with special knowledge in the handling of life

We have many, many personal success stories in Scientology. They begin with a book acquaintance and bloom when professional skill enters the background. These people, small people, big people, drove a wedge for themselves into companies, societies, with Scientology and then took over control of the area. They succeeded where they never would have dreamed they could. And every time one of us drives in such a wedge, we all win because the world is brought nearer to a sane and decent world.

The factories, the marts of trade, the homes, the neighbourhoods, these are the places we want *trained* Scientologists. In that way alone, we're on the busy, still healthy communication lines of the world.

Some of us need to run centres and schools just to give the rest of us service when required. Training at a pro level must continue and *must* be kept good. And service and communication must be given. Hence, we have Central Organizations on every continent and HCOs. But if we avoid the throbbing comm lines of the world and act like doctors, we will not win soon enough as a group.

Any trained Scientologist can win to success in society. Heightened IQ, a knowledge of life, a forthright attitude — with these things it is easy for him or her to improve a social or business position, to get higher pay, to exert wider personal influence. This we know we can do, we have done it so often so let's improve the ability.

Process people weekends, run a co-audit some evenings of the week at home, but get on the active lines of the world and make your presence felt.

It takes full training to do it. It's been done from our books alone but not always well. It takes tough Academy training to make a Scientologist, so don't go at it half armed.

And stop feeling apologetic because you are not a "full time auditor\*'. We are the auditors to the world, not to a handful of the sick.

We are not doctors. We are the world's trouble shooters. When we make a company win, the whole world wins, when we make a neighbourhood win, we all win.

A full time Scientologist makes life better wherever he is. And that is enough pro activity for anyone.

What do we expect of *you?* To become the best Scientologist that can be and to get on the comm lines of the world and bring a big win where it counts. We don't expect you to hang up a shingle as a doctor and have a private practice. We'll

respect you if you do. But we'll respect you just as much and even more if you get trained as a pro and go out and up in the world of action and of life.

Hit for the key spots by whatever means, the head of the women's club, the personnel director of a company, the leader of a good orchestra, the president's secretary, the advisor of the trade union — any key spot. Make a good sound living at it, drive a good car, but get your job done, handle and better the people you meet and bring about a better earth.

And stop feeling hangdog because you "aren't auditing full time". Nobody expects you to

We'll keep centres going to service your needs, some of us, we'll provide ammunition and books. And the rest of us had better invade every activity there is on a high level of success and make our influence felt on the comm lines of the world,

Scientology is the only game on Earth where everybody wins.

So let's help the world win.

- 11. To actively decry the suppression of knowl edge, wisdom, philosophy or data which would help Mankind.


- 12. To support the freedom of religion.

- 20. To make this world a saner, better place.







uring this past year, the International Association of Scientologists has supported actions all across Europe to bring about a climate in which Scientology can expand so that all Europeans can take advantage of the new Golden Age of Tech.

Never before have so many actions been taken to handle the suppressive elements that are attempting to bar the road to freedom - or so many actions taken to bring the truth about Scientology to the people of Europe.

### FREEDOM MAGAZINE

One of the primary vehicles for getting constant and incorruptible communication out is *Freedom* magazine. *Freedom* is now published in more than 13 editions in 7 languages.

In jus! the last year there have been 21 new *Freedoms* funded by IAS grants. Three *Freedom* magazines were published for the United Kingdom, three were published for France, five were published for Germany, two for Spain, two for Italy, two for Denmark, and one each for Canada and Austria. Two *Freedoms* for Switzerland, one for ihc French speaking part and one for the German speaking part, were published.

There is no other magazine in the world like *Freedom*. Each issue of *Freedom* is individually written for the country in which it is distribuled. Il not only exposes the corruption that underlies the attacks on Scientology in (hat country, but provides readers **with** the (ruth about Scientology, **truth** which (hey will find in no other news publication.

IAS grants both fund the production of *Freedoms* and their widespread distribution to individual cilizens, government officials, religious leaders, universities, libraries, police, schools, media and politicians.

After the distributions of *Freedom* in a country, the number of people coming into Scientology orgs for more information, to buy books or to see the film *Orientation* invariably increase. Many originate thai they have been interested in Scientology for some time and the *Freedoms* have catalyzed (hat interest and they have come in lo gel started. Distributors *of Freedoms* arc finding people arc becoming more and more familiar with the magazine and are reaching for the new issues as they come out.

### **GERMANY**

IAS grants have funded major actions to bring about peace for Scientology in Germany, a country where anti-religious hate campaigns are sponsored by an undemocratic government. For many years the IAS has supported a major effort lo safeguard the rights of Scientologists in Germany to practice their religion and lo end the religious discrimination rampant in (hat country.

Early in 1996. IAS grants funded the printing of 3.5 million copies



of a leaflet and its distribution all over Germany, II was estimated (hat one in ten households in Germany received **this** leaflet about Scientology. On (he front were photographs of nine ordinary people. Tt asked the question. "What is wrong with these people?" The inside headline answered: "Nothing, right? Then why are they targets of hale, persecution and violence?" The leaflet went on to lay bare the crimes of discrimination against German Scientologists and to provide the true data on Scientology. It invited them to visit a Church of Scientology and gave the addresses and phone numbers of all of the Churches in Germany.

Responses like this letter to a Hamburg newspaper, the *Abenclblatt,* have been the result:

"I received a direct mailing from the Church of Scientology of Hamburg which puts the Church in a totally different light. 1 took the time to cheek the facts they have given out and I must say that your way of treating the Scientologists is not only unfair but is extremely dubious. 1 live in a housing estate that has 600 residents who all got (he mailing. Most of them are *Abendhhilt* readers. I talked to quite a number of them about your general atliiudc regarding the subject of religious belief. Without exception. I can say all of them have been amazed and disappointed how your newspaper found it possible to alter faels in such a way to promote your vested interests."

Shortly afterwards, the IAS funded the publication of a 78 page booklet which gave a description of the Scientology religion and published statements from European religious scholars about the religious nature of Scientology. It made known ihe many community activities of Scientologists in Germany and proved false the lies that the German government had spread about Scientology. This booklet, called *The Farts Behind the Headlines*, was sent to all members of parliament, political leaders, religious leaders and media heads.

A "white paper" is an in-depth authoritative report prepared for distribution to officials or politicians with a special responsibility lor. or interest in. (he subject of the report. Two "while papers" have been published regarding discrimination in Germany, The first one published this year was about religious discrimination in Germany. Utilizing ihc results of research into Germany's religious intolerance, this report was designed for use wilh government and political leaders and civil rights groups outside of Germany. 25.000 copies were printed of (his ISO page paperback book entitled *The Rise of Hatred and Violence in Germany*,

A second while paper called *Religions Apartheid:* 1996 - Official Repression of Minority Religious Rights in Germany was published in both English and German and further documented the discrimination against Scientologists and oilier minorities in Germany. 20.000 copies were printed and broadly distributed within Germany and internationally - with copies going to the United Nations, the European Parliament and the US State Department.

Because religious discrimination in Germany has been exposed by IAS-funded publications and *Freedom* magazines there is now a widespread outcry against the German government. Not just from (he general populace, but from the US Stale Department. Ihc United Nations Commission on Human Rights, the Helsinki Watch and other human rights groups.

For the *second* consecutive year, Ihc United Nations Human Rights Commission condemned human rights abuses in Germany. And for ihc *third* consecutive year the United Stales Stale Department issued their annual Human Rights Report condemning Germany for its suppressive treatment of Scientologists.

Within the last year, international censure of ihc disci iminalion against Scientology in Germany has reached an all time high. As it became known that German politicians, in (rue Nazi (radilion. were calling for boycotts of movies starring Scientology celebrities because of their religious beliefs, the criticism of the German government Hooded in.

Internally in Germany, progress is being made in the war against suppression on the legal front. A case had been brought against a Scientologist who had handed out Church literature on the street. The issue was really about free speech and religious persecution. The government's strategy did not

work: The judge nol only ruled in favor of the Scientologist, but wenl further in staling "the religious nature of the Church of Scientology cannot be questioned under any circumstances." He also made it clear that no German official has the right to twist the law for his own suppressive ends. The City Officials were ordered by the court to pay the court costs and recompense the Scienlologisl for all legal fees. Since thai case, there have been favorable decisions in seven similar cases.

In 1994. with funding from the IAS. a scries of public information messages were placed in *The New York Times* which broadly made known the human rights violations and religious discrimination against Scientologists in Germany.

These messages, along with *Freedom* magazines and other publications funded by the IAS, effectively brought this dangerous situation to the attention of the general public and lo the United Nations, the U.S. Slate Department and human rights groups. The resulting censure of the discrimination perpetrated by the German government has helped slcm the abuses, but there is much to be done lo bring about full religious freedom and peace for Scientology in Germany.

A new series of public information messages has therefore recently been made possible by grants from the IAS. In some of these full-page messages, parallels are clearly shown between the [he false statements made by the Nazis in the 1930s about the Jewish people and the frighteningly similar statements being made today by the German government about Scientologists.

Others show that, just as Nazi officials in (he 1930s denied reports of atrocities against the Jewish people, the current German government denies that Scientologists are being subjected to discrimination today.


Many readers of *The New York Times* have called lo express their outrage at the behavior of the German government - and to find out more about Scientology. These messages arc bringing pressure lo bear on the German government to end its discrimination and human rights violations.

A second scries of public information messages is also being funded by granis from ihc IAS in *The Economist*. This highly respected magazine is published in the United Kingdom and widely read by governmenl and business leaders throughout Europe.

The firs! full page message in *The Economist* opened with the headline, "At Last...The Inside Story of Scientology," and continued: "You may have heard of Scientology; it is frequently in the news... Bui in the midst of the newspaper articles, the radio discussions, the TV talk shows, the political rhetoric, *one* question is never answered: What really *is* Scientology?" - and then provided more information about Scientology lo ihc readers.

Future full-page messages will cover the basic beliefs and practices of Scientology, the humanitarian works of LRH, and the wide range of social reform efforts in which Scientologists arc active. These are all being funded by granis from Ihe IAS lo help bring about peace for Scientology in Germany.



### **FRANCE**

This year more progress has been made than ever before in bringing aboul a favorable environment in which Scientology can expand in France, IAS grants have funded a total of five special editions of *Freedom* for France, of which three were published this year.

IAS grants also funded the French editions of the booklet *A Description of the Scientology Religion*, a collection of expertises entitled *Experts Study Scientology* and a brochure for the "Say No To Drugs" campaign. These publications have strongly contributed lo the efforts to bring about a new era for Scientology in France. One can sec the results of these efforts in (he expansion of the Churches in France. The Church of Scientology Paris has recently moved to larger, better quarters where more Scientologists than ever before arc taking advantage of the smoolhcr and faster road lo freedom now possible with the Golden Age of Tech.

### **SPATN**

On May 13. 19% in celebration of the 15th anniversary of the Church of Scientology in Spain, a "What Is Scientology?" exhibit was presented in the prestigious Rilz Hotel in Madrid.

The construction of this exhibit and its presentation were made possible by a grant from the IAS. In addition to a complete walk-through exhibit which clearly and simply presented (he basics of Scientology, the exhibit included a computer on which the new Internet web site on Scientology could be visited.

Visitors included judges, police officials, professors, members of the government, representatives from minority religions in Spain, Catholic nuns, leaders in the business community, altorncys and others. Scientologists brought friends and relatives. The exhibit was also well attended by both national and international media and news of the exhibit appeared in newspapers and was carried by CNN Hispanic Radio which aired a 10 minute show on 384 radio stations in Spain and elsewhere.

Because of this grant from the IAS, many key people in Spain were introduced to Scientology by I lie in-dcplh exhibit and many more heard the good news about Scientology in Spain on television and radio and in their newspapers.

Other actions which arc safeguarding the rights of Scientologists lo practice their religion freely in Spain have been funded by the IAS this year. These include the printing and distribution of 50,000 copies each of Iwo special editions of *Freedom* for Spain. These *Freedoms* were distributed to national and provincial parliaments, media, police, universities and religious leaders.


### THE UNITED KINGDOM

The IAS has funded a tolal of five *Freedoms* for the United Kingdom, and three of them were published this last year. As in other areas, these expose the hidden crimes of those who arc putting barriers in (he way of Scientology expansion and provide readers with ihc truth aboul (he Scientology religion and the many community activities undertaken by Scientologists.

All (old, more than 140,000 copies of *Freedom* have been **distributed** in (he United Kingdom in this year alone.

One major break through occurred in the UK this year which is directly the result of IAS-funded actions to help bring peace for Scientology in the UK.

In September 1996. television viewers in the UK saw something different on their television screens: the first Scientology ad aired in the UK. Television ads for Dianeiics and Scientology are a common

occurrence in olher pans of Ihc world, but a prejudiced and discriminatory ruling by the Independent Television Corporation (ITC) had prevented the Church from advertising in ihc UK. In a suit against (his entity, the Church filed a copy of an expertise written by noted UK scholar Bryan Wilson on the religious nature of Scientology.

The ITC reversed its ruling, and the doors were opened to television advertising and a whole new era of dissemination in the UK.

The lAS-funded ad contains a very appropriate quotation from the works of LRH. "On the day when we can fully trust each other, (here will be peace on Earth." The ad was such big news that all of the major television and radio stations announced its release - and played the ad as part of their news programs. As a result, an estimated 250 million people both in the UK and internationally saw the ad. UK orgs have reported a flood of people coming in to buy books, to find out more aboul Scientology and to see the film *Orientation*.

### **EXPERTISES**

The program embarked upon last year to gather from (he world's leading aulhorilics on religious matters their formal written opinions (expertises) on Scientology, has been funded by IAS grants. As can be seen in (he case regarding advertising in the UK. when dealing with judges, media and government officials, "academic opinion¹¹ is of great value. The most widely recognized and respected experts from Oxford University, the Universities of Rome, Paris, Capetown. Stockholm. Buenos Aires, Helsinki. Tokyo and olher cities all over the world have prepared scholarly studies on Scientology.

They have conducted their studies, visited Scientology Churches, talked to Scientologists and have written their findings. The results: They have all found Scientology to be, unequivocally, a religion in the truest sense of the word. Their studies have now been published and distributed to universities, libraries and opinion leaders and have been utilized in human rights symposiums.

These expertises are now being translated into all ihe major languages of the world. By ihe time this project is completed, there will be 600 versions of the expertises in 24 languages. And every religious scholar, judge, university and major government agency will have received copies of them.

These expertises are also studied by students of sociology and religion in all (he major colleges and universities of the world, and wilh Ihc widespread distribution of these to universities, they will reach an international academic community and provide students with everything they need in the way of an academic reference on Scienlology. This long term project has been funded by grants from the IAS.

IAS grants this year have funded more publications, defense actions and dissemination actions in Europe than ever before. In Denmark. Greece. Switzerland, Italy. France. Germany, Spain, Austria and Sweden the IAS is funding the actions that will bring about a true peace for Scientology and Scientologists in Europe.

Surveys in Europe show that popular recognition of Scientology is higher than ever before. IAS-funded publications in individual countries arc bringing the truth about Scientology directly to the populations of these countries. Because of Freedom, because of ads they see in newspapers or broadcast from the UK, because of exhibits such as the "What Is Scientology?" exhibit in Spain, and because of IAS publications people arc learning the (ruth: Scientology is the road to freedom and a better life. And the SPs are learning (hat there is a group that will not stand by and let religious .persecution and intolerance go unchecked.





In Canada. IAS members arc confronting and handling the feeble attempts of a few SPs to block Scientology expansion.

Through grants, the IAS is funding actions to safeguard religious freedom for the Church and Scientologists in Canada.

Concurrently. IAS grants arc helping to make known the (ruth about the Scientology religion to the people of Canada. IAS grants funded the placement of ads containing LRH quotes about positive social values in theatre programs. These publications are read by people in positions of influence in society who need to be aware of what Scientology is and docs. Ads have appeared in theatre programs for performances at major theatres and for the Toronto Symphony Orchestra.

A special edition of Freedom magazine was printed and 50.000 copies were distributed throughout the country lo key religious, community and judicial leaders. This was the largest Freedom ever printed for Canada.

Churches in Canada reported a dramatic increase in the number of people coming in for more information and to buy books after the *Freedom* was distributed,

The suppression of psychiatric abuses stands in the way of clearing fhc planet and bringing freedom to mankind. Cleaning up the field of mental health is of primary importance to Scientologists who are outraged by the damage caused by psychiatric abuses falsely labeled as help.

The most effective measure lo date in exposing and handling psychiatric abuse has been the publication of six booklets which fully explain the insidious influence of psychiatric abuses on six major sectors of society and the \community. These were released at the IAS 11 th Anniversary celebration in 1995 and were completely funded by IAS grants.

Published in 7 languages, the demand for them has been completely unprecedented. The first printing of 660,000 booklets was sent lo (he elderly, racial minorities, clergy, abused women, parents and judges. The response was a flood of requests for more copies of the booklets. A second printing of 1.5 million was funded by an IAS grant and when these were sent out, requests for even more flooded in. The demand reached an average of 2,000 booklets per day at its peak and in one six week period alone. CCHR mailed out 126,000 requested copies of the booklets. A third printing has now been done and there are now more than 3 million copies of these booklets which have been funded by Ihc IAS.

The effect these booklets are having cannot be overstated. They are a real international weapon against psychiatric abuses and are telling people in no uncertain I terms about the true nature of psychiatric abuses and what (hey can do about them.

These booklets arc being used to fight back against the abuses of psychiatry. One local director of a Citizens Commission on Human Rights Chapter was working on a case involving a psychiatrist who had been convicted of insurance fraud. The psychiatrist was trying to gel a reduced sentence through the use of an "insanity" plea. The CCHR Director sent the judge presiding over the case a copy of *Psychiatry: Eradicating Justice*, After that the judge denied the psychiatrist's insanity plea and stated in her final sentencing (hat she had thought about it, but decided the abuses and future problems of the psychiatrist's patients cancelled out any "problems" he might have been having.

Clergy of all faiths have been particularly enthusiastic in their praise for the booklet *Creating Chaos - Psychiatry: Destroying Morals.* 

The pastor of a Protestant church wrote, "It is refreshing to read such a well-done documentation on what has occurred over these past few decades to erode the moral fiber of our nation."

A Roman Catholic priest requested 25 more copies saying, "The publication (heme hit the nail on the head. We are slowly destroying all sense of personal responsibility. Psychiatrists have acquired the prerogative of infallibility and dictating morality, completely ignoring the free will the Almighty God has blessed us with/"

News media, judges and others responded overwhelmingly (o *Psychiatry: Eradicating Justice*. A US Federal Judge wrote, "I must admil thai it is a 'page-turner.' The alleged over-utilization of justice-thwarting psychiatric experts in criminal cases was startling."

Psychiatry: Victimizing the Elderly lays bare Ihe shameful fate of senior citizens in the hands of psychiatry and the responses lo (his have been overwhelming. A spokesman for a group representing 33 million retirees in the United Slates wrote to CCHR calling this booklet an excellent pronouncement on the subject.

One response to the booklets even came from a psychiatrist in Pakistan who wrote, "I have been working as a mental health practitioner in a small town for the past year. I was transferred here as punishment for refusing to give ECT (electro-convulsive therapy, "shock treatment") and other injurious Irealmenls.

"I was working singly and friendless until now, bul now I know that I am not alone and there are many brothers and sisters working for the same goals all over the world. This means very much to me.


"I have already succeeded in publishing a devastating article against ECT in three local newspapers. This work must have reached thousands of people. My efforts are historically the first against ECT in this unfortunate country."

And so it is with all of these publications. They have been placed on the comm lines of the planet by ministers of various faiths in their sermons and in their community work with gangs. They are being utilized by government agencies and grass roots groups, by police training officers to train policemen on how psychiatric abuses have destroyed the justice system, by parents and teachers to keep children off psychiatric drugs and by domestic violence counselors.

Wiih these booklets, CCHR has reached 634,886 groups representing hundreds of millions of members around the world.

### **BOOKS FUNDED BY IAS GRANTS**

In October 1995, two new books were released at the IAS I11h Anniversary Celebration: *Psychiatry: The Ultimate Betrayal*, the most authoritative expose on psychiatry ever written and *Psychiatrists: The Men Behind Hitler*, a

meticulously researched and thoroughly documented book, which conclusively proved lhal (he men behind Hitler, and the real villains of the death camps and euthanasia programs, were psychiatrists.

Since their release, these books have been in great demand with more than 6,000 copies distributed to news media, government officials, judges, religious leaders and others.

Since the release of the books and booklets, news media coverage of CCHR's work and psychiatric abuses have dramatically increased. In the year prior to their release. CCHR reached 160 million people by radio with its message. Since the release of these publications in Ihc last year, this has climbed to 279 million people.

By television, in the year prior to their release, CCHR reached 291 million. In ihc last year, this increased to 498 million people.

Bu( Ihc most dramatic increase was in newspaper coverage of CCHR aclivities: The year prior lo the release of these publications. 199 million were reached. Since October 1995. Ihis has now increased to 786 million.

These IAS-funded publications, in the hands of CCHR *are* shattering psychiatry's false image and are providing, for the first lime, truthful information on psychiatry.

### CLOSING OF PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITALS IN ITALY

CCHR Italy has a long history of exposing Ihc horrors of Italian psychiatric hospitals where men, women and children have been warehoused in filih and degradation while being controlled wilh powerful psychiatric drugs.

It was in 1980 lhaf Scientologists in Italy began uncovering Ihc crimes against humanity lhal had been perpetraled, and hidden, by psychiatrists and first published (hem in *Freedom*. CCHR's investigations continued throughout the 1980s and 1990s and the results were increasingly publicized in Italy,

As President CCHR Italy, IAS Freedom Medal Winner Roberto Cestari. accompanied by government officials and media, conducted many "raids" on psychiatric asylums in Italy lo expose the desperate conditions in these hospitals. He filed hundreds of official complaints which inspired dozens of parliamentary investigations.

IAS-funded *Freedoms* and publications spread the news even further. But the aim was not to just continue lo expose the situations in these institutions, but to gel them handled. And in the last year a major breakthrough has occurred.

The Parliament of Italy has declared in a resolution, thai all of its 91 state-run psychiatric institutions arc lo be shui down and (hat the government is required lo make sure that their doors are closed by December 31, 1996. The Parliamentary Resolution cites as its sources the broad photographic and documentary evidence obtained during investigatory raids on 20 asylums conducted over the years by the Church of Scientology's Citizens Commission on Human Rights. This puts Italy well on ils way lo becoming the first country to be free of (he grip of psychiatry.

### HEARING INTO PSYCHIATRIC ABUSES HELD IN BRUSSELS

lAS-funded actions have made it possible to brief Ihc European Parliament on psychialric crimes and abuses as CCHR executives from Europe and CCHR International met in Brussels in June lo present this data lo members of (he European Parliament a( a special hearing into psychiatric sexual abuse and other human rights violations.

Top experts, including Dr. Thomas Szasz. Professor Emeritus and author, provided dala on Ihc real intentions of psychialry, including graphic examples of the crimes being committed daily in the name of "help" in many of the European countries. AH were presented with copies of the books *Psychiatrists: The Men Behind Hitler* and *Psychiatry: The Ultimate Betrayal*, that had been funded by (he IAS.

The hearing provided CCHR with a forum to expose European psychialric abuses and (he need for every country in Europe lo implement the Council of Europe's Recommendation on "Psychiatry and Human Rights" that will help eliminate these abuses. IAS Freedom Medal Winner Paul Rood was instrumental in organizing this hearing.



nn Roberts, a Patron with Honors from the UK. has worked with Applied Scholastics programs for many years. Assisted by grants from the IAS, she has been extremely successful in bringing LRH study (cchnology to the African country of Zimbabwe. Because of her work, die school system of an entire town is now using LRH study tech - and she is well on her way to gelling LRH study tech used throughout the whole couniry.


With her **first** grant from the IAS in 1994. Ann was able lo carry out (he first study tech program as a pilot for primary and secondary school staff to demonstrate its workability to the Zimbabwe government. This pilot program was so successful that it was expanded and (he original teachers were given further training to enable them to become supervisors and train their colleagues in LRH study lech.

The purpose of the program was to factually improve the quality of teaching by making sure (hat (he teachers were applying LRH study technology in the lessons they were (caching.

The training program consisted of iwo parts. First was a checksheet of study based on *The Basic Study Manual* and secondly a practical checksheet which culminated in a demonstration lesson in which the teachers were required to show, in front of their peers, that they could incorporate LRH study technology into their leaching. A total of 344 teachers have now been trained. This is over one (hied of all of the teachers in the district, and more than 12,000 students are now being (aught with LRH study tech principles.

The program has become extremely popular among (he teachers of Zimbabwe who want to sec it expanded throughout (he country. This enthusiasm for LRH lech has kept the program going strong over the last two years and has made it easy to gain support al administrative levels.

As a result of the efforts of IAS Member Ann Roberts, by June of (his year nearly all of the teachers in the entire mining town of Shurugwi have been (rained in LRH study lech, making il (he **first** study lech town on the planet!

In a world in need of workable technology, making people in influential positions aware of the wealth of LRH technology available (o them is of paramount importance. Because LRH\s technology has been found so extremely beneficial by millions of people in all walks of life around the world, the IAS has been intent on making his valuable data known to as many people as possible so it can be put to use. Scientologists have personally experienced the enormous benefit of the technology of Dianetics and Scientology: they now want to be sure that others find out about it loo. As a result of grants made available by the International Association of Scientologists, more information about LRH than ever before has been distributed to presidents of major countries, ambassadors to the United Nations, congressmen, senators, ministers of nations, members of parliament, royalty, judges, chiefs of police and law enforcement officers,

120,000 copies of a special edition of *L. Ron Hubbard: A Profile* were sent to these opinion leaders and to the media and bookstores. This resulted in a tremendous number of reaches for more information <sup>1</sup> about LRH and his works - including one from a large chain of stores who, after 8 years of no response, has now expressed interest in stocking LRH books.

Another IAS grant funded the printing of 125,000 copies of *Ethics, Justice and Civilization* - a special edition *of Ron: The Humanitarian.* This was distributed internationally to government and political leaders, judges, correctional facilities and institutions, parole and probation officers and police chiefs. This publication highlights the humanitarian work of LRH and covers why current justice and prison systems are doomed to failure - and at the same time provides the solutions found in LRH technology.

Law enforcement officers, probation officers, judges and wardens who had given up hope of salvaging criminals, have found hope as a result of LRH technology. Thousands of requests for more information on LRH and his technology were received after the distribution of *Ethics*, *Justice and Civilization*, Criminon was literally deluged with requests from prison officials wanting help. Some wanted lectures on

the Criminon program for their staffs, others wanted copies of *The Way To Happiness, Introduction to Scientology Ethics* and the *Ups and Downs in Life Course.* Criminon was recently given a grant by the IAS to expand their delivery to inmates and help to meet the incredible demand for LRH criminal rehabilitation technology.

A Police Chief wrote of *Ethics, Justice and Civilization*, "Once I started reading. I could not put it down until I had finished the entire publication. I look forward to receiving other publications." And a longtime police official wrote, "I have read three or four of Ron's books and he has helped me to understand people and particularly the mindset of criminals both young and old in my twenty years as a police officer and chief of police."

In Hungary an official in a political party now wants to see LRH's penal code implemented in that country.



A recent IAS grant is now funding the widespread distribution of a special edition of *Ron: The Philosopher*, called *The Rediscovery Of The Human Soul*. By introducing more and more people in influential positions in society lo the work of L. Ron Hubbard, these distributions are offering them hope and workable solutions.










he International Association of Scientologists was formed at Saint Hill in 1984 with the signing of the Pledge to Mankind. Throughout the last year, members around the world at 25 different IAS events again rededicated themselves to the goals and purposes of the IAS by re'Signing the Pledge to Mankind. The purpose

of the Association is to unite, advance, support and protect Scientology and Scientologists in all parts of the world so as to achieve the Aims of Scientology. Since its formation, the IAS has made great strides forward in accomplishing this purpose.

#### **UNITING SCIENTOLOGISTS**

Never before in the history of Scientology have we had a more briefed, informed and united team of Scientologists. Attendance at the IAS Fifth Anniversary Event held at Saint Hill and satellite-relayed to orgs internationally was the largest of any IAS event ever held.

This last year saw many members appointed to the IAS Senior Honor Roll for having signed up over 100 members for the Association. Members are working to see that the Scientologists they know are connected up and made part of the group.

City Offices in pioneer areas. There is a large reach from African nations for LRH\* technology and IAS grants have made it possible for Expansion Office Missionaries to open offices in Ghana, Nigeria, Kenya and Tanzania. Most recently a grant has been made to enable an office to be opened in Ethiopia to deliver Dianetics there.

Another area which the IAS has supported is Education Alive in South Africa. The most recent grant has made it possible for Education Alive to deliver LRH study technology to high school students in the black townships *of* South Africa.

This year saw the first cracks in the Iron Curtain and the first reaches from the Soviet Union for LRH drug rehabilitation technology. The Soviet Union, along with most of the rest of the areas on this planet, has rampant drug and alcohol abuse problems. The IAS recently issued two grants that are smoothing the way for the export of LRH drug handling technology to Russia. One grant made it possible for a delegation from Moscow to visit the new Narconon\* installation at Chilocco which is rapidly becoming the world's largest drug rehabilitation center. The second grant made it possible for a team of Scientologists to visit the Soviet Union to begin preparations to hold a concert there promoting drug-free lives. This concert will feature Scientology celebrity performers.

By supporting such projects as opening new areas to Scientology and providing basic LRH technology to extremely oppressed areas of the world, the Association is working to create sanity in areas which are otherwise extremely volatile. It is these areas in particular which are desperate for LRH technology and know they need it to survive in an increasingly dangerous environment.

### SAFEGUARDING OUR PERSONAL AND RELIGIOUS LIBERTIES

One of the most serious threats to personal and religious freedom in the world today is an organization called INTERPOL. Most people consider INTERPOL to be a government agency - which it is not. It is a private organization originally founded by NAZIs which has been closely involved with NAZIs all the way up to present time. INTERPOL has been found to be the source of the spread of lies and false information on the Scientology religion which has caused us difficulties in many different areas of the world.

The IAS made available a grant to produce a booklet informing the public about the dangers of INTERPOL. The" booklet is for government officials, business leaders, the media, legislators and concerned citizens. This private organization with a NAZI past and present is a major threat to personal privacy and liberties on this planet and is actively forwarding drug trafficking and criminality. The IAS also gave grants to produce this booklet in French and German.

Most individuals and even governments have not had the confront to handle the criminality and suppressive actions of INTERPOL and have looked the other way. However this huge block to freedom must be removed. One of the first actions is to inform people of what INTERPOL really is and the dangers of its products. To do this, the Association provided a grant for the printing of the booklet INTERPOL: PRIVATE GROUP, PUBLIC MENACE which covers how INTERPOL presented medals to Manuel Noriega of Panama and Mohammad Zia ul-Haq of Pakistan for fighting drug trafficking when both were kingpins of the drug trade. The booklet also summarized INTERPOL's NAZI history and present connections and lays out in detail how INTERPOL is violating the individual privacy and future security of individual citizens.

The IAS has just recently given grants to translate this booklet into French and German. Another grant is making it possible to investigate the corruption of INTERPOL officials in Puerto Rico, one of the areas of greatest drug trafficking between the southern United States and Central and South America

## DEFENDING SCIENTOLOGY AND SCIENTOLOGISTS

French Scientologists have been very active in carrying out anti-drug campaigns and exposing the involvement of INTERPOL in drug trafficking. (INTERPOL has also recently moved its headquarters to Lyon, France.) It was not surprising then that churches in France soon came under attack. The attack was immediately met with the launch of a Crusade which is in full swing and has resulted in positive media coverage throughout France.

Association Member Julia Migenes, very well known as an opera singer throughout Europe, has been working closely with the Crusade and holding press conferences speaking out in defense of her religion which received wide coverage in the media.

Members of the Crusade, including Association members who came from Germany, Switzerland, Denmark, Belgium, Sweden and Holland have held marches at the INTERPOL headquarters in Lyon and at the Ministry of Justice in Marseilles.

Meanwhile, Churches and missions in France are continuing to deliver LRH technology to the public in

Chilocco, the world's largest drug rehabilitations center has just recently opened to deliver LRH drug rehabilitation technology. The IAS supplied the grant that made possible the original research for Chilocco and many members have been instrumental in launching this vital new installation. A Russian delegation recently toured Chilocco with the help of an IAS grant, with the hopes of being able to bring LRH drug rehabilitation technology to their homeland.

greater volume than ever before. The booklet exposing the crimes and sordid history of INTERPOL is being distributed widely.

Because of the support of Association Members, both those who have participated in the French Crusade and those who, through their donations to the IAS make it possible for the IAS to give grants that keep the Crusade operating, the future of Scientology is being assured in France.

#### PROTECTING THE SCIENTOLOGY RELIGION

Another way in which the IAS is protecting the future of the Scientology religion is by supporting actions of the Citizens Commission on Human Rights. In the last year, IAS grants have made possible the production of six different Public Service Announcements which have appeared on radio and television to alert the public to the dangers of psychiatry and psychiatric drugs. These hard-hitting announcements inform the public that psychiatry kills and warns them of the dangers of the psychiatric drugs being so frequently prescribed for children.

The actions of CCHR ANZO have also been largely supported by the IAS in the last year. This area has been extremely effective in exposing psychiatric abuses and cutting the reach of psychiatry. Through the actions o(CCHR), two Royal Commissions have been called to investigate psychiatry in Australia, criminal charges have been brought against psychiatrists involved in the "deep sleeps" treatments that resulted in the deaths of over 40 patients. "Deep sleep\*' therapy has been banned in New South Wales and mental health legislation has been formulated to better safeguard the public against the abuses of psychiatry.

The IAS provided support to a campaign to expose IRS abuses and attacks on personal liberties. Victims of IRS abuses were brought to Washington, D.C earlier this year to speak to the media and to legislators about how the IRS has harassed them and violated their constitutional rights.

# INCREASING THE SIZE OF THE MEMBERSHIP AND "WAR CHEST"


Since its formation 6 years ago, the Association has continued to grow in size and strength. There are three categories of membership and six categories of honor statuses in the IAS.

Honor statuses in the Association are:




