





Use the momentum created there to engage in activities that will contribute to reach the Aims of Scientology here on planet Earth. It is very easy!




Thank you for sharing this with the membership. Your contributions to the fight for religious freedom in France are well known.



have been studying the subject of modern government. As you know I was trained in this subject (in one of the Universities the reporters say I never went to).

Nearly every major country in the "free" world has been sporadically at war, by which I mean guns and soldiers, in one place or another since 1945.

Only one country has not. That is Russia. Her 2,000,000 man army, amongst all major armies, has only had two brief actions—Hungary and Czechoslovakia. Instead she engages in guerrilla support or insurgency attacks by local partisans over the world. She is engaged in this and continual propaganda attacks. By this she has kept in action all other major armies serving as "security forces," in "brush fire wars" or revolts.

Obviously the lesson is plain. To defend an area one must attack.

All other major nations are fighting within their own territories or on those of allies. They are fighting on their own soil or that of allies. They are losing. There isn't a ripple in the Russian homeland.

So in this universe the winning tactic must be to attack. The losing tactic must be to only defend. These "brush wars" are inflating the funds of rather extravagant western powers. It cost France 1 million Pounds a day to combat (and lose to) guerrilla forces in Algeria. It is costing the US \$40 billion to \$50 billion a year to "police" Vietnam. That was the total national budget a few years ago! Thus Russia is wrecking western currency and economics as well.

But the main thing I have scouted out is that these guerrillas or insurgency forces who start these "brush wars" have to have a powerful cause. It has to be powerful enough to attract large portions of the local population.

The "free" world invalidates these insurgent causes. But a cause great enough to bear one's breast to western machine guns, to starve and die for, must be quite a cause.

If such a cause can generate such local support and eventually win over whole populations, then it must be founded on real, not imaginary, abuses.

No guerrilla force agitator can build total support with empty slogans. There has to be sound solid reasons that each supporting member of the population can know for truth out of his own personal experience.

So there have to be abuses on the part of the governing forces. There must have been "It has never occurred to any western power that they themselves now have no adequate cause."

abuses for a long time. And nobody in the government did anything about them. And so, slogans or no slogans, lies or no lies, there had to be real factual abuses. Enough to bring about revolution.

Western powers have not been subject to any "divine doubt." They know they are so right it hurts. They never seem to question their own actions or procedures. They just back them up with guns and troops.

IT HAS NEVER OC-CURRED TO ANY WESTERN POWER THAT THEY THEMSELVES NOW HAVE NO ADEQUATE CAUSE.

Obviously if a prime re-

quisite of guerrillas is a cause, then what's needed is a bigger and better cause on the part of the Government.

And it isn't there. And its lack is costing them money, men, the cold war.

In Kenya they defeated the Mau Mau, gave loyalty certificates to a lot of the population — then lost the whole country and the holders of the certificates were killed. All for lack of a government cause, strong enough to be fought for.

So, this makes us review, in light of our own experience, the whole subject of western government.

One finds that they are governments by pressure groups, which is to say, vested interests. Some time ago they ceased to be governments of the people and became governments by the pressure group, of the pressure group and for the pressure group.

These pressure groups (such as the psychiatrist or the "international banker") are often very vicious, quite mad. With bribery, terrorism, false reports, and 3rd Party actions such groups drive the politician into attacking the population, whether by easy seizure of persons or oppressive taxation or merely over-regulation and over-inspection.

In 1945 with the advent of atomic bombs, governments could no longer meet the definition of a sovereign power which is "protect the land and people from foreign aggression." There is no real defense against these bombs and 12 nations are now possessors of them.

So for this and other reasons, governments apparently ceased to protect the individual, and the average social group. Instead they began (in their derangement) to attack them. In small ways or large, the attacks were real. They required defending against in slow, biased courts at great expense.

It was almost as if governments in most cases were trying to force a revolutionary action into being.

The main problem of the individual or group, harrassed, left without protection, overregulated, subjected to abuses without any protection from the government, is to keep from becoming a revolutionary individual or group.

In our own case, if we had less stability, we would have joined forces with some revolutionary group, driven there by harrassment. We are, in policy and fact, refusing to become revolutionary.

have us driven underground and into the arms of some insurgent activity.

Now if we experience this, we are not alone. Attacked for nothing, we tend to individuate or introvert. But if you call around to other groups you will find we are more successful in defending ourselves and are suffering less attack than they are.

Cheerily, we would have helped our governments for the last two decades. We had real help to offer. Even our support as a religious group would have been valuable and often was. We also had real technical help for them in their most pressing problems. And every action from any government so far is not only no protection but also outright attack. For no crime, not even a

misdemeanor, we have been ridiculed, mocked, fought and knocked around by our governments who followed the orders of the pressure groups.

So these Western governments are capable of gross abuses. Governments that attack writers, religions, peaceful social groups are never long for this world. When they attack Scientology, the highest level of mental tech on the planet, and actively support and finance the sordid seizure, torture and death of psychiatric victims they must be utterly mad themselves.

So what's this cause they offer? Some insurgent group comes up with any cause at all and the population goes for it.

The law on this is that WHEN FACED WITH A CORRUPT AND OPPRESSIVE GOVERNMENT, THE POPULATION TENDS TO JOIN ANY GROUP WHICH THAT GOVERNMENT ATTACKS WITHOUT EVEN ASKING FOR WHAT THE ATTACKED GROUP STANDS.

In other words they are all being attacked so they identify themselves with anyone else being attacked.

If the attacked group has shown spirit and defiance and attacked the government in its turn you then have a revolution. Those are the crude mathematics of revolution.

As oppressive governments have no real cause that anyone would really fight for (who wants to protect the puppets of a corrupt pressure group?) then any popular insurgent cause is adequate to rally a population.

Our problem then is to refuse utterly to be forced into the position of revolutionaries. It is hard to do.

Somehow we must get these governments to clean up their own houses before they are carried down by the outraged mob. The end of that would be complete chaos.

The main area where they err is in attacking their own people. Justice is not for the poor. Any false report by any of these depraved pressure groups can get any individual or group into severe trouble. It costs vast sums of money to defend in modern courts. The average person does not have it. Therefore human rights must be made a fact, not an idealistic dream.

The very basis of human rights is freedom from false accusations and from brutality and punishment without offense.

Somehow, government by prejudice and false report must end in the West or the West itself will end. "The very basis of human rights is freedom from false accusations and from brutality and punishment without offense."

By bringing about real human rights, perhaps there would be enough cause in the West to be worth fighting for.

Somehow society in the West must be revitalized after decades of arduous degradation.

It will not be an easy feat. It is very hard to save a being or government who is bent whole-heartedly on selfdestruction.

We are trying to get these governments to clean up their own houses and so preserve themselves.

We are trying to get the society to revitalize after decades in the mind of decayed animalism.

It's a large order. But remember this, if we do not succeed then it is the end of the free world and the probable end of everything we know of Western civilization.

On the other hand there are social groups and people without count who, given liaison with one another and a uniting of their spheres of influence, will help us.

We must try very hard to wipe out these attacks on us and refuse steadfastly to be forced into a revolutionary activity or into the arms of insurgents organizing even now to destroy every government in the West.

If we, with no crimes on our hands, can be remorselessly attacked, if the bad hats only are protected and their crimes ignored, then we have a gauge of the task before us.

We are already reversing this trend.

We do have a chance of succeeding all the way. We are the only group in the West that is standing its ground and winning.

OPENHAGEN,
DENMARK: The International Association of Scientologists annual convention of delegates was held in this Scandinavian capital city.

To celebrate the first successful year of the Association it was decided to hold, in addition to the convention itself, a huge and *In*ternational briefing for the Scientologists and Association mem-

bers in Europe.

The International Association of Scientologists has had a very productive and successful year to celebrate. Formed only a year ago, the Association is now 12,000 members strong with members in 38 countries around the world. This rapid expansion has been due to the work of members who are dedicated toward achieving freedom on this planet.

The celebration of this first year had to be something very special — an event which would inform Scientologists of the many Association activities and a setting for some major Association presentations. Such an evolution required a great deal of

preparation.

The International Membership Unit was asked to assist on setting this up in Copenhagen. They worked with Association members at CLO (Continental Liaison Office) EU, in AOSH EU & AF and in New Era Publications to prepare the way for the convention and event. A special new presentation book by L. Ron Hubbard was published for all first year members, the Annual Report was prepared for the convention, the Religious Freedom Award Medals were struck in gold and silver, and detailed arrangements were made for not only a spectacular event in Copenhagen, but as well for videoing the event and simultaneously relaying it by satellite to three other European cities.

As the preparations rolled foward throughout September the excitement built as members from all over Europe made their travel plans to be in Copenhagen or one of the other cities where the video relay events would occur: London, Paris and Milano.

A truly international event was underway! In order to ensure that the audience in Copenhagen could fully follow the messages from the event speakers who would be delivering their talks in English, simultaneous translation facilities over headsets were arranged for those in the audience who wanted to take advantage of this facility. Association members trained in translation arranged to be there for the event and assist the Association with their skills.

In order to ensure that the recording and relay of the event was of the highest possible quality, equipment was contracted from a major video firm in Gothenberg, Sweden and, directed from a state of the art control room, Association member John Gutierrez and the crew of Golden Era Productions recorded, directed and relayed the event. Reports from each area indicate that reception at each site was excellent, quality superb. The event itself was fully recorded for editing into a video production to be shown around the world.

CONVENTION OF DELEGATES

Scientologists in each major country or continental area chose delegates to represent them at the annual Association convention. The delegate meeting was held in the Advanced Organization/Saint Hill of Europe in Copenhagen.

AOSH EU staff were proud to host this first annual convention. A large banner welcoming the delegates was stretched across the front of the building.

On the day before the convention delegates representing the United States, England, New Zealand, Australia, South Africa, France, Germany, Italy and the Mediterranean, South America, Switzerland, Austria, Canada, Denmark, Sweden, Norway, Holland, Greece, Belgium and Spain/Portugal arrived in Copenhagen. The International Association of Scientologists covers the globe!! As the delegates were arriving, members from around Europe were preparing for their arrival. International Association members are an international group!

A weekend of theta and celebration of the progress made in guaranteeing freedom and dedication to the future had begun!!

ANNUAL DELEGATES MEETING

On a bright Copenhagen Friday afternoon, the delegates representing Scientologists from around the world met to review the previous year and make plans for the coming year.

The accomplishments were many: in one year the Association had been created and grown to 12,000 members.

Over 40 major briefings and events had been held around the world to brief Scientologists and members on the Association's activities.

The Association's membership rolls and operations had been computerized.

Computer readable membership cards had been issued to all members which identify them as a member of the Association.

Members had received their new membership cards with a "Welcome to the Association" package which detailed the benefits available and vital LRH data — information which hatted them as members.

IMPACT, the Magazine of the International Association of Scientologists, had begun as a bimonthly magazine to members and was helping get them in comm with one another and with the Association.

The Crusade for Religious Freedom was born in Portland, Oregon, when Scientologists and Association members rallied to the call to FIGHT BACK. In the face of formidable odds, Scientologists won a major victory.

The Crusade for Religious Freedom spread to

many other locations around the world — most notably France where the Crusade took the cause of religious liberty to the United Nations office in Geneva.

The status of Patron of the Association was established and over thirty members have decided to use their considerable financial resources to assist the Association and thereby be awarded the honor title of Patron of the Association.

Beautiful new Association pins in gold and enamel have been made and issued to those members who have signed up five new members or who have made outstanding contribution toward achieving the goals of the Association.

The Association has established a special honor category to recognize those members who have made outstanding contributions or who have signed up twenty new members for the Association. They are awarded Honor Roll Status by the Association.

Delegates were presented with the annual report and briefed one another on how Association members in their home areas were becoming more and more active.

The delegates also set goals for the coming year. Much progress has been made in the past year on the way to freedom — and in the future year much more progress will be made as the delegates and all members work to achieve the goals adopted at the convention.

In a spirit of cooperation and dedicated purpose toward achieving the Aims of Scientology, each delegate signed the goals for the next year, signifying their intention to see these through to completion.

In the process of obtaining our ultimate goal, there is the need to have other lesser goals which mark out continued forward progress. In 1951, L. Ron Hubbard wrote of this in a Dianctics Auditing Bulletin where he stated: "Only the deterioration of the goals of the group or the reaching of all the goals of the group can bring about the decline of the group or the individuals within it. It is therefore incumbent upon any group to have a postulated set of goals which are continuing goals; to have a major goal which cannot be reached all in a breath but also to have minor goals which go in progression toward major goals which go in progression towards super-major goals."

The event crowd in the auditorium was an international blend of Europeans. With flags of the different nations being held aloft in the auditorium and the usual pre-event talking and greeting going on in a hubub of different languages the stage was set for the presentation of the speeches and the awards.

This event was unique in many ways, one of the main things that




The medals themselves are especially struck for the Association and are made from silver and gold.

Thus the psychs with their rantings and electric shocks wear their own brand clearly marked on them by their own conduct in life.

"Recognize them for what they are; psychotic criminals — and handle them accordingly.



I brought you some news as to what LRH is doing right now. He has been working to strengthen and smooth the route up The Bridge. He has been continuing his heavy schedule of research and writing. And while he told us in his message at the start of this year that he was very hard at work on the upper reaches of OT, the record shows that he's also found the time to give us a wealth of new technical and administrative tools.

The most recent major tech release from LRH is New OT I, heralded as "a brilliant weapon against eons of spiritual darkness". LRH discovered that there are certain factors which, when handled, can greatly speed a Clear's progress up through the OT levels, and New OT I is designed to do just that! The level consists of 36 steps, done in a precise sequence.

There's another astounding rundown released by LRH this year called the Allergy and Asthma Rundown. This rundown addresses common and physical difficulties with a spiritual approach to them.

I'm sure you are familiar with LRH's incredible False Purpose Rundown which was released in 1984. Well, in addition to that LRH has now released another eight rundowns which go along with the False Purpose Rundown. These new actions include Second Dynamic False Purpose Rundown; Money and Finance False Purpose Rundown; False Purpose Rundown for Artists; False Purpose Rundown for Students; False Purpose Rundown for Auditors; False Purpose Rundown for Security Checkers; Dissemination False Purpose Rundown; and Executive and Staff Member False Purpose Rundown (which is applicable to anyone who works with or for an organization of any sort).

LRH has also given us several brilliant new issues on handling of conditions, new Academy Level checksheets and a new Book One Auditor course.

Those are just a few of the technical breakthroughs we have received. In addition to this, Ron is also working on recording the OT levels that have not been written up, so that they are available for you when you get up The Bridge classification and gradation chart.

I also wanted to brief you on the size and the magnitude of the expansion and dissemination that is occurring on LRH's written works. Books are the fastest and the best way to get people in and started on the Road

to Total Freedom.

First of all this year we have *Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health* which was published in Portugal. The first printing of this book sold out within a few days and the second printing is already underway.

In Italy, *Dianetics* has been a best seller for weeks. Self Analysis has been released in Italy and that too is a best seller on their national lists and in that same country, we now have *The Problems of Work* and *Dynamics of Life* available.

We have another book which opens up a new territory; Dianetics: The Modern Science Of Mental Health, released in Israel and printed in Hebrew.

Then in Indonesia, we have opened up a whole new area for Scientology philosophy with the release of *The Problems of Work*.

And there is *The Learning Book* for China. Let me tell you something about this book. The Chinese publishers decided all on their own, to put in a photograph of LRH and include a little biography on Ron, right at the beginning of the book. 20,000 copies of that book were printed up in China and they are already having to go for a second printing which is absolutely a first ever.

In addition to this, we also now have: The Learning Book and The Basic Study Manual in Indonesia. The Way To Happiness and Dianetics in Spain. Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health in Greece. The Way To Happiness in Thailand. Dianetics, Self Analysis and The Learning Book in Yugoslavia. Dianetics in Kenya, Nigeria and Ghana.

You get an idea of the expansion we are talking about. It's unprecedented.

I'd like to close by telling you about something that is very exciting, something that is the first in the publishing industry, something that has never occurred before. And it concerns LRH's hat of fiction writer. You have heard of a trilogy — three books. Well, Ron has created another first. He has written a collection of 10 books! LRH has coined a new word: DECALOGY which means 10 books. These ten books comprise ten separate stories but they're all part of one huge big science fiction adventure. This first volume has just now been released in the United States and the rest of the ten books are scheduled to come out probably over the next two years.

So you see that L. Ron hubbard continues to open up new frontiers in his researches into the mind and spirit and his books on these topics are gaining an even wider popularity as they are published in different countries and languages around the world. Now he's also taking the fiction world by storm and setting trends and becoming a leader there as well. I indeed salute L. Ron Hubbard for these accomplishments; all of which add up to expansion with a capital "E".

Expansion of the Association

"c) participant members who fully contribute to the group and its goals and who are contributed to by the group; and which has high ARC between goal and management, management and group, group and goal."


I have a little story which I feel is appropriate in relation to the formation of the Association. We have had a bit of an evolution occur, In 1982 there was a new management that swept in and cleaned out the noise that was messing up the expansion of the Scientology religion and in the process of that, as LRH covered in RJ 38. "Today & Tomorrow—The Proof", actually turned around the Church management and set things going on a different path.

Having handled that management and having remedied that aspect of the goal to management, we then came to the next evolution and the next step which is to actually enhance the group and by forming the International Association of Scientologists we now open the door for a group to come to be that, on equal terms, can get in ARC and move forward in attaining that goal at an even faster rate.

We now have in the Association 12,000 members. 25% of the members are Lifetime Members. We have members in 38 different countries — in Saudi Arabia, Japan, United States and every Western European country.

The membership pack was put together by the Association as a hat. If we are going to have a true group, a true group needs to have hatted group members. And this next year another hat will be coming out as a step to continue to brief people and hat them.

Another part of having a true group is having a comm line or communication between group members. The IMPACT magazine just started. It's 56 pages long, full color, and goes out every other month. The object of the magazine is to keep in communication. It has in it the first

The Association is, as LRH says in "An Essay on Management", a true group. This is the group of people, of Scientologists who are making sure that no matter what happens, LRH goals and dreams are going to be made to come true. It is the group which is making sure that a few suppressives won't be ever allowed again to enslave billions of others.

LRH says that nothing ever stays the same. It either expands or it shrinks. The enemies of the Scientology religion are shrinking in numbers and effectiveness. And the Scientology philosophy is expanding.

The total number of staff members in the Church has been increasing steadly. There are over 8,500 internationally. We are growing.

There are many areas of this planet which a few years ago didn't know the Scientology philosophy at all and today they count members, groups, organizations.

In Italy just 10 years ago there were basically no Scientology groups at all. Today, there are nine organizations and a few weeks ago Italy as a country received continental status. It is now managed directly by Flag. It has a Continental Liaison Office in Milano of 80 Sea Org members. And it has the newest Class IV Org on the planet — Lissone.

Europe over the past years has seen tremendous expansion. In 1977 there were no official organizations or

Churches south of a line that goes from Paris to Munich. South of that line today, we have nine large organizations in Italy, three organizations in Spain, one in Portugal, one in Israel and four organizations in Switzerland.

At the same time expansion is taking place in other areas as well. There is a new organization in California opened up called Stevens Creek. It has over 100 staff members now.

Also the new Advanced Organization which opened in July 1983 in Australia is delivering nowadays over 300 hours of solo auditing to pre-OTs that are going up The Bridge. It is doing very well and has been expanding ever since it was opened.

The top of The Bridge, the Flag Service Org has been in a boom. It now counts 9 HGCs which deliver up through new OT VII.

Expansion is also taking place in far away places.

A few months ago a book called *The Learning Book* which is a book on LRH study tech was published in China. 20,000 copies were published and these have all been sold out in a few months. At the same time, at the invitation of the Chinese government, staff members from Social Coordination went to China. They trained teachers in the University of Peking to deliver study tech. They also recorded a TV show on *The Way To Happiness* and Study Tech will be shown to and seen by 50 million Chinese.

When we talk expansion, the key point is dissemination of Scientology and Dianetics technologies. The first thing is to get LRH books into people's hands. It is the front line of Dissemination.

Many areas have been engaged in doing massive campaigns to get DMSMH out into society.

The mission in Frankfurt has made an arrangement with about 1700 taxi drivers for all of these taxis to carry advertisements for Dianetics.

A massive DMSMH campaign has been launched again in the United States with a new edition of the book and 70,000 copies have been distributed to bookstores. This was started in a major book fair in New York.

There is a new newspaper that gives the results of Dianetics technology, actual success stories, things that people have gained from Dianetics technology. This "Dianetics Today" newspaper has been distributed to all of the bookstores and was distributed very broadly at the New York book fair and people were walking away with this newspaper and were very interested in it.

And how are we going to do this?

By being more causative, wearing our hats and engaging in a totally coordinated push.

We are probably the only people on the planet absolutely sure of where we are going.

A Year of Great Victories

This is the year of the International Association of Scientologists. We have arrived. Because each of you, each of us has fought for freedom. Something has changed on planet Earth and it is a major change. I want to say that this has been a year of great battles and a year of great victories.

Let me cover some of the things that have happened. In Germany, the Bavarian Court of Appeals ruled that auditing is an essential religious activity of the Scientology philosophy. Therefore the legal concept of a commercial enterprise cannot be tied to the Scientology religion. And that is the hard work of a number of people. A government agency tried to de-register the Church and now we are fully recognized as a religion. So thank you!

Attempts were made to close down the Church in Munich using trade laws and trying to apply those trade laws to churches. A suppressive person there tried to assert that we were trying to heal. In that particular case we proved that psychiatry has tried to remove the religion from the society but that the Church is really doing what should be done in the field of religion. We are putting religion into the society. This person from Munich lost his case and the Church again won more freedom for the Scientology religion and for mankind.

We now have won 13 cases in Germany since the beginning of this year and since the International Association of Scientologists was formed.

In Italy the government had brought a fraud case against the Church there. They lost the case. We won the

In Paris, Celebrity Centre Paris has received a letter from the tax office informing them that their tax exemption from unemployment tax has been approved and they will be paid back their back payments for the last five years.

This was also the year the Religious Freedom Crusade was born in the town of Portland, Oregon in the United States. You came, Scientologists from around the world. You were there every day with your voices raised.

And back home Scientologists continued to work to expand the Church and its activities. There was a unification, a coming together, a growing together. And religious leaders came from around the world because they were concerned that religious freedom continued to exist. Because if religious freedom is lost for one group then it is lost for all groups.

And therefore in Portland, Oregon a new postulate was made, a group postulate, a mass group postulate, a theta postulate that has grown and grown. In Portland the impossible happened and that group postulate blew apart a whole picture of suppression and we can see that we have freedom because L. Ron Hubbard gave us a technology that made us different, that gave us a chance.

And men of good will of other religions joined the issue as well and that brought more power and more energy as well. And so in Portland, Oregon a Crusade for Religious Freedom has begun and it has already stepped out across the world and all of us are a part of this crusade and we will go forward until we have won it for everyone.

These are only a few of the gains made since the formation of the International Association of Scientologists. We have come a long way but we have a long way to go. Our strength is in LRH Technology and we will not fail in the cause of religious freedom.

Scientologists are willing to work for change and are willing to change the environment rather than adjust to it!



The Lawyer's View

Harry Manion, Lawyer for the Church of Scientology: One of the Attorneys on the Portland case and largely responsible for the legal victory, Lifetime member of the International Association of Scientologists.

I was part of the battle of Portland. In fact I was there from day one until the final day. We waged the battle in the courtroom daily. And then when we lost the verdict we waged it for 60 days.

I'm here to tell you that we PRODUCED the mistrial.

And there is a very simple explanation as to how we did it

— we used the tech!

I learned some lessons that I want to share with you from Portland. I think we as Association members all must share in these lessons so that the mistakes, and what occurred in that courtroom, never repeats itself.

The first lesson is that lawyers cannot win this thing alone. I wear my lawyer's hat, but I'm nothing more than your mouthpiece. My partner and I and the executives and the officials who run the Church of Scientology and all its branches, only speak FOR YOU. And therefore it's not sufficient when an attack is made upon Scientology philosophy to say "Oh, let the lawyers handle it." Or "let the executives handle it — that's what we have them for." That's not sufficient. And you know it.

Because the answer is in the tech — it's up to YOU to handle it and that's what happened and that's how the disaster of Portland has been turned into, metamorphosized into, the greatest constitutional victory of the 1900s.

It was done by people like yourselves who just said "Enough. Stop. Time out. We won't tolerate this any longer."

So, the first lesson I'm trying to share with you this evening is don't ask us to do it alone. If you're there with us we're undefeatable. Alone — we're just lawyers.

Friends have asked how I like representing the Church of Scientology. I am impressed by the honesty, integrity and decency of the people I met. I had never encountered in my seven years of practicing law a more decent upstat funloving group of people. We worked 18 hours a day, seven days a week and although we labored under tremendous pressure and the stakes were very high, the Scientologists that I lived with for 3½ months never lost their optimism, their good naturedness or their sense of humor and they continued to be an inspiration for me.

This second lesson I learned was translated into action. I asked my terminal in the Church to obtain for me an Annual Membership in the International Association of Scientologists. Because, as I sat there in that courtroom day in and day out, getting madder and madder as a parade of really inconsequential people made a mockery out of my client's and my friends' religion, I said to myself and my family, if those little people can take away this great religion today, they can take away mine tomorrow and yours the next day. And I'm not going to stand for it and the International Association of Scientologists is the vehicle that's not going to stand for it.

So I wrote my check and I filled out my membership card and I became a member of the Association and I'm very happy I did!

Over the last three months, my partner and I have reviewed all of the litigation. It's all one and the same. It doesn't even require that much legal work because the theory is the same. It's psychiatric backed, it's backed by small people who are scared of you. They're scared of you and what you stand for.

Freedom's a frightening concept. And there are some people that just can't allow it to exist.

I had a cognition that these SPs have to be stopped once and for all. And I don't think legal is the answer. Because the courts are only a stage. They'll move to other stages after we exterminate them there. They'll move on and on. The only answer is the International Association of Scientologists. So I became a Lifetime Member and I proudly wear my pin!

We're confronted with a problem. And when I say we, I'm not speaking about lawyers. I've already told you I don't have much confidence in those folks. I'm speaking to you as a fellow member of the Association which I have a right to do because I'm here to ask you to help me with my problem. Because its not mine, its OURS.

We're confronted with squirrels who are altering the tech, packaging it up and passing it off in an altered form. Now how are we going to handle this problem. Well, we could hire lawyers — let them fight it out in the court — we all know that's a joke.

We could say to ourselves, "let's let the executives handle it. We don't have to trouble ourselves with it. They're fully competent. The people who have spoken here today are excellent administrators and great executives. It's

I want every single one of you to become Lifetime Members of the International Association of Scientologists.




New Book for All Members



Summary of the General Membership Rules

for the

International Association of Scientologists

- Any Scientologist who is in good standing with the Church of Scientology may become a Member of the Association.
- Anyone who is not a Scientologist but who is in agreement with the Pledge to Mankind and the Aims of Scientology may, upon contribution to the Association, be accorded the status of Associate by the Association. Associate status does not entitle the holder to the benefits and privileges of Membership.

 There are three categories of Membership: Beginning Membership, Annual Membership, and Lifetime Membership.

 Beginning Membership is available for new Scientologists. There is no fee for Beginning Membership. Beginning Membership is valid for a period of six (6) months and is not renewable; an individual may obtain Beginning Membership only once.

The benefits available to Beginning Members include those benefits extended to Association Members by the Church. Beginning Members will receive the magazine published by the local Church of Scientology as well as other information and promotion as issued by the local Church.

However, Beginning Membership does not entitle the holder to benefits granted by the Association to its members. The Association reserves such benefits for holders of the remaining categories of Member-

 Annual Membership, or "Regular Membership" as it may be called, is valid for one year. Membership fee for Annual Membership is \$300 U.S., or equivalent in other currencies.

Annual Membership may be renewed upon expiry by payment to the Association of \$300 U.S., or equivalent. Annual Membership entitles the holder to all the benefits and privileges granted by the Association to its Members as described in this magazine.

6. Lifetime Membership is valid for the duration of the present lifetime of the holder. Membership fee for Lifetime Membership is \$2000 U.S., or equivalent in other currencies. Lifetime Membership entitles the holder to all the benefits and privileges granted by the Association to its Members as described in this magazine.

7. Honor Roll status may be awarded by the Association for outstanding contribution as designated by the Association. Honor Roll status is valid for the present lifetime of the holder. Honor Roll status entitles the holder to all the benefits and privileges granted by the Association to its Members as described in this magazine. Special mention and awards are given to Honor Roll Members.

The Association will specifically award Honor Roll status to any member who signs up 20 new members as such will specifically be helping to meet the 1986 goals set by the Association.

The Association will similarly acknowledge with Honor Roll status any member making exceptional donations to help the Association in building its "war chest" which will be used solely for the guarantee that Scientology may be delivered undisturbed throughout the free world.

- 8. Beginning Members may obtain Annual Membership or Lifetime Membership at any time. Annual Members may obtain Lifetime Membership at any time.
- Membership in any category is not transferable between persons, nor is any right, benefit or privilege of Membership transferable.
- The Association accepts donations in any amount from Members or non-members for the furtherance of its purpose and the realization of its goals.
- Membership fees and donations to the Association are not refundable.
- 12. Membership in any category, or Associate status, may be cancelled should the Member, or Associate, publicly disavow or attack the Association or, in the case of a Member, fail to remain in good standing with the Church of Scientology.
- 13. Members are required to keep their mailing address up to date with the Association so vital communication may be relayed. The Association in turn, will guarantee that such information is kept secure and only used in forwarding the aims of Scientology and the purpose of the Association.

IDEAS, NOT BATTLES

Part 1 of an exclusive series

The history of Western Civilization has been tainted with opposition to new ideas. New positive upward thrusts in man's awareness and capability have been opposed, attacked and vilified. Scientology and Dianetics, since they arrived on the world scene in the nineteen fifties. have been treated no differently. This series of articles, called "Ideas, Not Battles" from the quote from L. Ron Hubbard, "Ideas, not battles mark the forward progress of Mankind" will be a straightforward look at the progress toward freedom that the ideas of Scientology philosophy and L. Ron Hubbard have made since 1950.

The first area to be looked at is the treatment of the "mentally ill". What was the scene in 1950 when LRH wrote and released "Dianetics, the Modern Science of Mental Health"?

At that time, the "Psychiatric Establishment" was using various methods to "treat" the insane. The then newly discovered "Electro Shock" treatment was in full swing. Discovered by an Italian psychiatrist while watching pigs being slaughtered, it consisted of attaching electrodes to the head of a patient and applying an electric current (110 volts approximately)! This treatment was supposed to relieve the patient of various ills and definitely had the effect of making the patient quieter! A course of such treatment could go on for weeks with the patient receiving one or more shocks per day.

If this failed to cure the patient there was the "pre-frontal" lobotomy. Consisting of anesthetising the patient, taking a sharp metal instrument (such as an ice pick), sliding it up past the cyeball of the patient into the skull and slicing part of the front lobes of the brain.

There were other such "treatments" and many psychiatric patients died from them. The strange point here is that even the psychiatrists didn't have a clue as to what deas

they were doing — apart from trying to quieten down some patients! They even publicly admitted this!

The worst part of this was that the patient, because he or she was mentally ill, had no rights to refuse such treatment. Many thousands of people were sent to institutions without trial or hearing, and without having committed a crime and were doomed to years of extensive treatment of no value. There were no rights, no court protection. The only persons who could release the patient were the very people giving the treatment.

Psychiatrists were telling the world at large that "mental illness was likely to strike 4 in 10 of the population, and that 7 out of ten people would need to see a psychiatrist at some point in their life". With visibly disastrous results of psychiatry obvious to even an uninformed public, the field of the mind was obviously a dangerous and barbaric field to go into.

MAJOR PROGRESS IS MADE

On May 9th, 1950, Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health was released. It soared up the best seller lists, people in local areas got together to audit one another. Suddenly there was a sane, safe and scientific way to handle the mind. In DMSMH, L. Ron Hubbard said,

"Mental-physical therapy is too ridiculous, with the source of aberration now a science, to be seriously mentioned. For no thinking doctor or psychiatrist possessed of this information would touch another electrode for electric shock therapy or even glance at a scalpel or ice-pick to perform an operation on the prefrontal lobes of the brain unless that doctor or psychiatrist is himself so thoroughly aberrated that the act springs, not from any desire to heal but from the most utter and craven sadism to which engrams can bring a man."

With the surge in popular interest, one would have expected that the psychiatrist, relieved of the need to brutalize his patients in the name of treatment, would cast aside the electrode and the ice-pick and give them their place in history along with the leech, blood letting and ritual sacrifice. But no! The psychiatrists clung grimly to their grisly methods and, in defense of their crimes, attacked Dianetics technology! The fight has continued for thirty years!

In the late fifties LRH alerted Scientologists to the imminent danger of the "Siberia Bill" which would have allowed people to be sent to psychiatric camps in Alaska, without trial or rights. Scientologists banded together and lobbied successfully against the bill. Scientologists

running column of letters from Scientologists to communicate to other members and it's intended for that to expand.

Pieces of promotion were done to get the Association out of non-existence. One year ago the Association was an idea. One year later it's an actual group.

There is a new campaign to let people know who the members of the Association are and it's planned to regularly display two members and actually show what a member is and what a member does and what a member has to say about the group so that we know and it's not just one general statement, it's a statement from you and it's a statement from me and any other member.

There is a project to form a new ship upon which would go the release and delivery of New OT VIII and New OT IX. The idea was announced in an event at Flag last year. At that event we had the first public announced Flag New OT VII completion. Since then we now have 90 New OT VII completions.* The project is moving forward. Crew are in preparation, drilling and brushing up on their seamanship including two fully qualified captains so that this ship can get into action. There is a mission that is going ahead with the research and preparations in securing the ship so that we will have in a very short order, as those completions keep mounting up, a base for the delivery and release of those two new levels.

When the Association was formed we signed a pledge. This pledge was a postulate as to our continued growth and to alleviate any stops along the way that may be encountered. We've been making a lot of progress on that.

It was predicted that some people might have erstwhile intentions toward our expansion and that prediction was proved, as well as proved the power of the group as we went out and conquered each one of these barriers in Germany, in Italy, in the U.S.A. in Portland and in other cities and as we've done that we've turned the tides and begun an offensive action.

In the US we've begun to contribute 10 a campaign that is getting in ethics on the Internal Revenue Service. That campaign is being organized by a Congressman and contains 3 two-minute TV ads that are running nationally in the United States. The ads have at the end an offer for what is called an Action Packet. This has various data for people who want to contribute and includes a copy of the Freedom newspaper subscription. So they're going to be able to get the data as to what's really going on.

It has always been intended that the Scientology religion be a group activity where all members work together hand in hand and shoulder to shoulder. It was never intended for it to be anything but a true group and with this Association we have the makings of that group as long as each member contributes.

LRH stated in a Policy Letter titled SERVICE: "If the combined power of all of us and all organizations were exerted as a shoulder to shoulder effort, we would take this planet just as we are and with no more than we know."

I'm on the team and with you too on this team, we will continue to grow and nothing can stop us. This group is now making possible a growth we have never seen in the Scientology religion and that this planet has never seen.

The Association is making it possible for the Scientology religion to expand and continue to expand. I want to thank here all the members of the Association for their help so far. However we need the help of every Scientologist. Every Scientologist is to become a member of the Association because it is only as a true group in a shoulder to shoulder effort that we are going to make LRH's dreams come true.

One day a person asked me the following question, "What guarantee do I have that those fantastic goals are ever going to be achieved?"

And I said, "You're the guarantee and I'm the guarantee and that's all. It's only you and I that are the guarantee that this is going to happen. If we want to make it happen, we use LRH tech to make it happen and it will happen and only if we're all together in it."

I received this letter from a field Scientologist who is a member of the Association and is very active.

He wrote: "I'm the happiest person I know. Why? Because of a number of reasons that all boil down to the fact that I'm practicing Scientology technology every moment of my life. Here's how I figure it. As an FSM and as a Field Auditor I have observed that whenever one of my selectees or pes win I win too. That means that I am, in effect, not just getting wins from my own Bridge but from hundreds of other Bridges as well. In a very real sense I would estimate that over the years I've gone up close to 5,000 Bridges.

"I'm sure that most of you know how wonderful going up the Grade Chart can feel. Multiply that by 5,000 and that's how it feels being an active field Scientologist!"

It is only by helping others that one goes up. LRH says that no one will be truly free until we are all free. There are a lot of things one can do. One can be an FSM, a field auditor, a staff member. One can and must sell LRH books to others. One can form a gung-ho group, an OT committee. But something has to be done and we've got to do it all together.

LRH says in RJ 34:

"All things worthwhile have to be fought for: every decent impulse in Man's history has been opposed.

"The fate of the entire civilization is decided on the issue of which one wins.



Marchers brought the message for Religious Freedom across France and Switzerland to the United Nations in Geneva making many allies for the Church along the way. Marchers were led by Michel Raoust who has been awarded the Religious Freedom Award by the Association for his work.

In France, Opera star Julia Migenes addressed Scientologists at the start of the March from Paris to the United Nations in Geneva, Switzerland. March culminated in Geneva with a rally held near the UN with religious leaders and allies there to speak and to sign the Declaration of Religious Freedom. A delegation went into the UN to meet with the head of the Human Rights delegation and he met with them in private and expressed support for the cause.

Around the world Scientologists, led by members of the International Association of Scientologists are effectively making progress in keeping Religious Freedom alive in the world. campaigned for the rights of mental patients around the world with the result that in some states in the US it became law that patients had to be informed of the consequences of their treatment and give their consent before it could go ahead. Psychiatrists were sued by patients, public exposure of the conditions existing in mental hospitals forced change upon the face of the treatment of patients. Psychiatrists themselves strongly attacked their profession for its unethical practices. Dr. Thomas Szaz of New York University is one of the best known, a psychiatrist himself he has written a number of books on such subjects as "The Myth of Mental Iliness'

During this time Dianetics technology, and the religion of Scientology have grown and expanded manyfold. The membership of the International Association of Scientologists has continued to grow weekly ever since its formation. Members are actively working in many fields to guarantee the future of Scientology philosophy. Progress toward freedom is being made daily by active members.





The History of

SCIENTOLOGY ORGANIZATIONS Part 3



It is important that Association members be familiar with the history of our religion which has grown from one book written in 1950 by L. Ron Hubbard into the fastest growing religion in the world today.

In a series of articles, Impact will take a look at the growth of the Scientology religion from the earliest days to present time. Members who were involved in the early organizations are encouraged to write in with their stories and photos of those times so that these can be shared with other members.

*The Scientology symbol and Dianetics symbol are trademarks and service marks owned by Religious Technology Center. In 1952 a wind of change blew through the burgeoning world of Dianetics technology. Since the release of Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health in 1950, LRH had kept on researching and releasing his discoveries and records. LRH had released news of the "thetan"!!

Ann Saunders, now a Sea Org member at the Flag Land Base, was running a Dianetics Group in Washington, D.C. at the time. In an interview done at the Base she gave a picture of the happenings at the time. She and her husband had started their franchise by obtaining the mailing list of Dianetics book buyers from a Washington, D.C. Science-fiction store. Mailing out penny post cards to this list resulted in people arriving at the group from Baltimore, Virginia and the local area.

In 1952 there were three groups in the Washington area alone, two in Washington, D.C. and one in Baltimore. The groups ran Dianetics Co-Audits, with the group leaders supervising and advising students. There is no way of verifying the number of informal groups, clubs, or meetings where people were talking about Dianetics. But, that there was a huge groundswell of interest is obvious just from the groups which are known about!

Ann reports that in 1953 Dick Saunders went to Phoenix to find out about this "thetan" that they had heard about. As Dianeticists they were a bit confused and concerned that this radical new concept might undermine the concept of engrams and the basics of Dianetics technology. The news of LRH's researches put that uncertainty completely to rest and LRH's discoveries broke new ground for them once again. The Scientology religion was starting to spread and Dianeticists were eager to find out the latest news. Communication to Dianetics auditors was maintained with "Dianetics Auditor's Bulletins" and newsletters.

The official records show that in March, 1952 in Wichita, Kansas, LRH gave a lecture to professional students at the Hubbard College—"Introduction to Scientology: Milestone One". The word was being spread.

Later that year LRH moved this center of training to Phoenix, Arizona where the very first office for Scientology technology was formed and lectures were delivered by LRH. From these beginnings, and due to demand created by dissemination via lectures, the first of the Churches of Scientology formed up in 1954 in Los Angeles, California. Scientology applied religious philosophy was dawning on the world.

A Church of Scientology was incorporated in Auckland, New Zealand in the same year. Scientology philosphy was already international in scope by this time but this was the first official Church to be formed abroad. The next 4 years were to see the Scientology religion grow around the world. The next article in this series will take a look at the expansion of the Church.

Definitions

ARC: A word formed from the initial letters of Affinity, Reality, Communication, which together equate to Understanding.

Auditing: The application of Scientology processes and procedures to someone by a trained auditor. Auditing gets rid of unwanted barriers that inhibit, stop or blunt a person's natural abilities as well as gradiently increasing the abilities a person has so that he becomes more able.

Auditor: a person trained and qualified in applying Scientology and/or Dianetics processes and procedures to individuals for their betterment; called an auditor because auditor means "one who listens". An auditor is a minister of the Church of Scientology.

hank: a colloquial name for the reactive mind. This is what the procedures of Scientology are devoted to disposing of, for it is only a burden to an individual and he is much better off without it.

beingness: The condition of being is defined as the assumption (choosing) of a category of identity.

Birthday Game Implementation Program: [A program sent out to Scientology Organizations by International Management containing specific actions to do and Policy references to help the Org expand. The goal of the "Birthday Game" is to expand the org 5.4X by Ron's birthday.]

Book One: Book One of Dianetics, Dianetics: The Modern Science of Mental Health.

Bridge, The: A term originating in early Dianetic days to symbolize travel from unknowingness to revelation.

case: The way a person responds to the world around him by reason of his aberrations.

case supervisor: That person in a Scientology Church who gives instructions regarding, and supervises the auditing of, preclears.

Chart of Human Evaluation; [a chart which comes with the book, Science of Survival.] Human Evaluation, a diagnosis of behavior.

CF: [Central Files.]

Clear: A being who no longer has his own reactive mind.

Co-auditing: an abbreviation for co-operative auditing. It means a team of two people who are using Diametics or Scientology processes to help each other reach a better life.

C/S: [See case supervisor.]

Dianetics: dia (Greek) through, nous (Greek) soul. It is further defined as what the soul is doing to the body.

disseminate: To spread (ideas, etc.) widely.

dynamics: There could be said to be eight urges (drives, impulses) in life. These we call dynamics. These are motives or motivations.

ED: Executive Directive

E-Meter: Hubbard Electrometer. An electronic instrument for measuring mental state and change of state in individuals, as an aid to precision and speed in auditing. The E-Meter is not intended or effective for the diagnosis, treatment or prevention of any disease.

first dynamic: the urge toward existence as one's self.

Flagship: [the main ship of a fleet, on which the commander stays.]

FSM: Field Staff Member, Get people into the Scientology religion by disseminating to bring about an understanding of what the Scientology religion can do, thus creating a desire for service, and selecting the person for that service.

grade: The word used to describe the attainment of level achieved by a preclear. Grade is the personal points of progress on the bridge. Grade Chart: Classification Gradation and Awareness Chart; the route to Clear, the Bridge. It is a guide for the individual from the point where he first becomes dimly aware of a Scientologist or Scientology and shows him how and where he should move up in order to make it.

HGC: Hubbard Guidance Center. I/C: In Charge.

NOTs: [New Era Dianetics for OTs, advanced spiritual healing technology for OTs. (See New OT V, New OT VI and New OT VII on Ron's new Grade Chart.)]

Org Board: Organizing Board. A board that shows what functions are done in the organization, the order they are done in, and who is responsible for getting them done. OT: operating thetan, highest state

there is, overt, overt act: an intentionally committed harmful act committed in an effort to resolve a problem.

pc: preclear.

Postulate: (noun) A conclusion, decision or resolution made by the individual himself on his own selfdeterminism on data of the past, known or unknown.

preclear: A person who, through Scientology processing, is finding our more about himself and life.

pre-OT: a thetan beyond the state of Clear who, through the advanced courses, is advancing to the full state of operating thetan.

process: A set of questions asked by an auditor to help a person find out things about himself or life.

Registrar: In a Scientology org, the person who signs up people for Scientology service.

Scientology: Applied religious philosophy. Scientology addresses the thetan (the spirit). Scientology is used to increase spiritual freedom, intelligence, ability and produce immortality. Scientology is the study and handling of the spirit in relationship to itself, universes and other life.

Sea Organization: Is that organization which functions at a high level of confront and standard. Its purpose is to get ethics in on the planet and eventually the universe.

session: A period in which an auditor and preclear are in a quiet place where they will not be disturbed. The auditor gives the preclear certain and exact commands which the preclear can follow.

solo auditing: Because of the nature of OT auditing the person has to learn to audit himself as most OT levels are too fast to be audited by another.

Solo NOTs: [New OT VII. See NOTs.]

squirrel: 1. a squirrel is doing something entirely different. He doesn't understand any of the principles so he makes up a bunch of them to fulfill his ignorance and voices them off on a pe and gets no place. 2. those who engage in actions altering Sen, and offheat practices.

theta: Theta is thought, life force, elun vital, the spirit, the soul, or any of the numerous definitions it has had for some thousands of years.

thetan: The person himself — not his body or his name, the physical universe, his mind, or anything else; that which is aware of being aware; the identity which is the individual. third dynamic: the urge toward existence in groups of individuals.

WISE: [World Institute of Scientology Enterprises.]

withhold: a withhold is an unspoken, unannounced transgression against a moral code by which the person is bound.


The Public Divisions would be buzzing with effective action and new people and furnishing a torrent of new names to CF.

The pcs would be getting full grades to ability attained for each, not 8 minutes from 0 to IV, but more like 30 processes. And they would be leaving with high praises.

The students would be graduating all on fire to

audit.

One could look at this ideal org and know that



this was the place a new civilization was being established for this planet.

The thousand or more actions that made it up would dovetail smoothly one with another.

And the PR Area Control would be such that no

one would dream of threatening it.


Members were very pleased with the event. Mr. Berg said, "I want to thank you for the beautiful event. It was perfect and I am proud to be a member of this group."







their hat. Let them handle it." We could ask them to do it. I don't think that's a solution.

We could ignore it and say that these squirrels are probably hurting only 10,000 or 20,000 people. Don't confront it. Ignore it. Go on with our lives. Go on with your processing. Worry about your case. Don't worry about anybody else's. But that's just out tech.

So what should we do? We should confront it — each and every one of us whenever we see or hear entheta we should step on it. Stomp it out. Using every legal means available to us. Don't pass it on to me. Don't pass it on to your executives. Handle it yourself. That's the lesson I learned about Portland.

Each and every one of us must be vigilant. And when it comes on our lines, handle it.

I also was reading an IMPACT magazine that, as a member of the Association, I read religiously. And I studied the "Code of a Scientologist" which was on the back cover of an IMPACT magazine.

And what the Code says is to do something! The only sin as I see it in my studies of Scientology is to do nothing and let the forces of evil and chaos go their merry way and wave at them. That's the only sin I can see. Every paragraph of the "Code of a Scientologist" says to do something. Point 16 is particularly appropriate to handling squirrels, "To insist upon standard and unvaried Scientology as an applied activity in ethics, processing and administration in Scientology organizations."*

The message I bring to you, my fellow Association members, is very simple. The message is that YOU are the reality, not the lawyers, not the organizations, not the execs, not the legal system, not judges, not juries. You and you alone are the reality. I have the honor of being one of your mouth pieces. But I speak only FOR you. You are my reality and I consider it a very very cherished and precious bond to have the honor to speak for you.

And I look forward to speaking next year at our second anniversary event. And next year I intend for my speech to be very short and very sweet. I will say the following: "Good evening, my fellow Association members, the legal war is over! We have won. The genius of I.RH has prevailed! The planet is safe for once for all and forever!"
